Ten months have now passed since you became an Ordeal member of Unali'yi Lodge 236. You are now eligible to seal your membership in the Order of the Arrow as a Brotherhood member. It is our hope that you will do so at the Fall Fellowship the upcoming weekend of December 12th, 2008.

In order to seal your membership in our Lodge, you must meet the following requirements, which can be found in your OA Handbook:

- 10 months service as an Ordeal member in the Lodge.
- Be a registered, active member in Scouting.
- Be a registered, active member in the Lodge (dues paid for the current year).
- Know, from memory, the Obligation, Admonition, sign, song, and handshake of the OA.
- Be able to answer the questions on pages 52, 53, and 54 in your own words.

In addition to the above, you must write and bring with you a letter addressed to the Lodge Secretary, Michael Marshall, explaining what the Obligation means, how you have been fulfilling this obligation in your troop, or crew and how you have used your understanding of the traditions of the Ordeal to aid you in your service. Describe also your specific plans to continue service to the Lodge, your unit, and the community as a new Brotherhood member of Unali'yi Lodge 236.
